

Overview of Privacy Policy

Wedever, a platform of Venuerific Pte Ltd, (“**Wedever**”) provides this Privacy Policy to inform you of our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use and disclosure of personal information we receive from users and members of www.wedever.co (the “**Site**”). By visiting and using our Site, you indicate that you have read, understand and agree to all terms and conditions stated herein. This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time and you are therefore advised to consult this policy regularly for any changes.

Collection of Information

When you use our Site, we may collect both personal and non-personal information about you. Non-personal information may include IP addresses and details of websites you have visited prior to arriving at and after leaving our Site. Personal information such as your name, contact number, email address, and organization may be collected when you use our services. The site has security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of information under our control. However, we do not warrant the security of personal information transmitted via the Internet and any information transmitted to the website is done at your sole risk.
